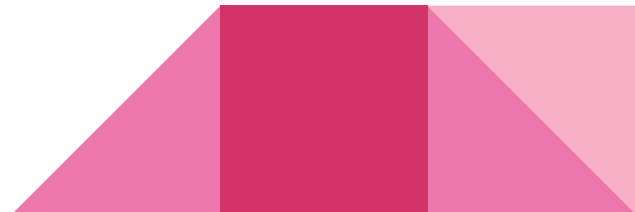

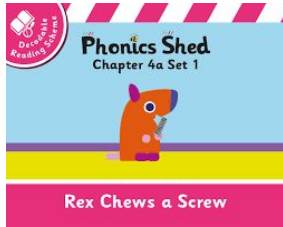

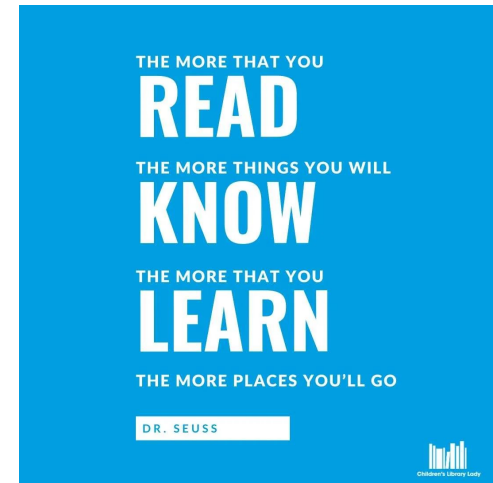

We recommend that children read for 10 minutes each day and that you hear your child read at least 3 times a week, ask them questions as they read and sign their reading record. Reading has the biggest impact on a child's ability to access the rest curriculum and your help and support is really appreciated.



Homework



Read every day if possible, but at least 3 times a week.

Practise multiplication tables using TT Rock Stars (from Spring term)

Practise spellings every day for 5 mins.

Spellings

- Your child will be sent home a weekly spelling list, consisting of 10 words, to allow the opportunity to practice in preparation for their test the following week.
- Children will still have access to Spelling Shed but will not need to complete games for their homework.



PE at Woodley in Year 2

- 2x PE lessons per week and will include invasion games, gymnastics, athletics and dance
- Wear PE kit to school on those days (days to be confirmed soon)
- White T-shirt, black shorts/joggers with a black jumper/hoody.
- Avoid wearing earrings on PE days.

We have three simple rules that everyone is expected to follow:



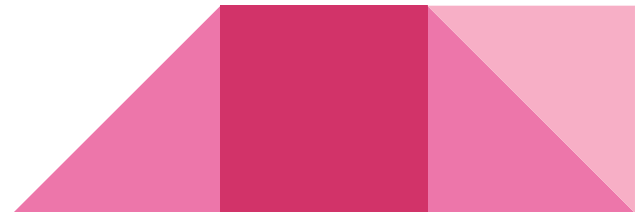
What happens when I make the right choice?
